- Fund return calculations

## Valuation

- Mark-to-market valuation of properties using various methods such as DCF, Direct Cap, Market Comparison and Cost Approach
- Fund unit and net asset value calculations
- Coordination of the review of 3<sup>rd</sup> party appraisal reports and understanding of valuation inputs/outputs
